**TERMS OF AGREEMENT**

**It is your responsibility to inform all participants in your party terms & conditions of this agreement.**  
All tour participants will need to have a signed Liability Waiver. Parent or authorized guardian must sign for those under the age of 18 years old. Please print enough liability waivers for all participants in your party.  
**They must be signed and ready by the tour time.**  
All tour participants must:

- Wear footwear appropriate for the tour – sneakers, hiking boots, etc. No slick-soled shoes, no sandals. **If you do not have on appropriate footwear, you will not be allowed to participate in the tour and will not receive a refund.**
- **Absolutely no one under 7 years of will be allowed in the Gorge.**
- Bring at least one bottle of water. Snacks are a good idea also, but should be carried in a backpack of some type so that your hands remain free.
- You may want to wear a hat and sunscreen, especially during summer months and in winter months dress in layers.
- If you have any health concerns such as bad or weak knees, ankles, hips, a heart condition, are overweight and get easily winded or fatigued, you may want to rethink this tour. **It is physically demanding.** In addition, it gets hot in the Gorge very quickly during sunny warm days, so please make sure you are well hydrated before and during the tour.

No rock or fossil collecting is allowed on Gorge Tours. No pets of any kind on tours, no exceptions.  
**\*\* The leaders (guide and docents) will be there 30 minutes before the tour starts. All guides and docents are volunteers!**  
Please arrive 15 minutes prior to your scheduled time and have your group leader check in with the tour leader. Please allow ample travel time for buses.  
**Email or call at least one week in advance if you need to push back the start time of your tour.**  
**In the case bad weather or denial of access by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers tours will be cancelled, so it is critical that we have a cell phone for the contact person listed above.**  
**Depending on what type of tour and shuttling requirements will depend on where you will meet your leader.**
